

Criteria for Exhibition Remuneration from Sveriges Konstföreningar

You must meet **one of the following three options** to qualify for exhibition compensation:

- 1) **Master's Degree** (MFA) from an accredited university of fine arts/crafts.
- 2) **Bachelor's Degree** (BFA) from an accredited university of fine arts/crafts AND at least two of the following merit credentials:
 - **Solo exhibition** at a gallery or equivalent venue
 - **Group exhibition** at a museum or publicly funded art center (konsthall)
 - **Grant/stipend** of at least 30,000 SEK from state, municipal, or regional bodies.
 - **Representation** in a publicly owned art collection (state, municipal, or regional)
- 3) **If you lack higher fine arts education, you must meet at least four of the following merit credentials:**
 - **Solo exhibition** at a gallery or equivalent venue
 - **Group exhibition** at a museum or publicly funded art center (konsthall)
 - **Grant/stipend** of at least 30,000 SEK from state, municipal, or regional bodies
 - **Representation** in a publicly owned art collection (state, municipal, or regional)
 - **Professional practice:** Active work as an artist/craftsperson through artistic consultancy, educational assignments, or other relevant professional arts training.
